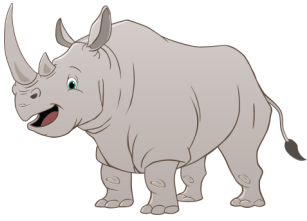


Roar 2019 Curriculum Summary
