What is a Crew Leader?

- ◆ A crew leader's job is to guide a group of 5-6 kids to crafts, games, snacks, Bible story, video, and singing. Crew leaders encourage the kids, play with them, and help them participate in each activity. Being a crew leader is really fun!
- ◆ Crew leaders must attend ALL 5 days of Bible school.
- ◆ Crew leaders DO NOT have to plan the lessons.
- ◆ In selecting teen crew leaders, preference is given to St. Mary parishioners, experience at VBS, and having forms in early. Please also read the page "Information for Teen Volunteers".
- ◆ All teens and crew leaders **MUST** attend ONE of the training meetings:
Saturday June 16, 10:30am OR Wednesday June 20, 7:00pm OR Sunday June 24, 7:00pm
- ◆ Crew leaders who are age 18 and older at the time of VBS must complete the Virtus program, including background check. Contact Judi Parker for information.

What is a Station Leader?

- ◆ Station leaders and assistants teach Vacation Bible school activities. The Stations are: **Bible Story, Crafts, Games, Snack, Video, Saints, Singing and Imagination** (experiments).
- ◆ Station leaders prepare a 20-minute lesson for each of the 5 days of Bible school and help gather materials. Detailed lesson plans are provided. Memorizing scripts is not required.
- ◆ Station assistants DO NOT have to work the entire week.
- ◆ Station leaders must complete the Virtus program, including background check.
- ◆ **Special talents** are also needed in the areas of: **decorating, painting, sewing costumes, acting, baking, photography, mailings, administration** and more. These tasks vary in time commitment and some can be completed in your own time before the week of Bible school.

2018 VBS Information for Teen Volunteers

Welcome teen volunteers! Thank you for helping our kids learn about God. We hope you have fun and learn some things too! Here is some information and requirements that you will need.

Application

- All volunteers must apply IN ADVANCE using the forms provided on the St. Mary website. No last-minute or walk-in registration for kids or volunteers. Teens (who are not volunteering) may not come and hang out with you during VBS.
- The registration deadline is **June 1** or whenever volunteer positions are full.
- The number of teen volunteers is LIMITED. (It's based on the number of children enrolled.) Preference is given to teens who are St. Mary parishioners, have previous experience at VBS, can attend all 5 days, and have their forms turned in early/promptly.
- The parent or guardian must fill out and sign the volunteer and medical forms.
- You must include phone numbers where the parent can be reached DURING the program.
- Teen volunteers MUST attend one of the training meetings.
- If teens are age 18 years or older at the time of VBS, they must complete the Diocese Virtus training. Please contact Judi Parker for information.
- The parents and teen volunteers agree to follow the rules of VBS and the directions of the adult supervisors. If rules and directions are not followed, or if there is any unacceptable behavior, the teen may be required to leave the program.

Dress

- Wear your VBS t-shirt! Dress for active play!
- Dress modestly and appropriately, since you are at Church.
- No cami tops, halter tops, bathing suits or revealing clothing.
- Shorts should be modest length. No short shorts, no yoga pants/shorts, no leggings.
- Wear gym shoes or sandals that stay on your feet.
- No flip flops, clogs, boots, or high heel shoes.

Hours

- Please arrive at 8:50am on the first day and 9:00am the rest of the days.
- Do not leave your crew or your station during VBS.
- Do not leave the St. Mary property during VBS.
- The VBS program is over at 12:30pm each day.
- If you have to leave early or will be absent, please give a note to Mrs. Parker.
